

VSDVVF Copy to New Computer Instructions

1. Insert a flash drive into the OLD computer. When prompted by windows: open up the flash drive to view its contents.
2. While leaving the flash drive contents window open on your screen navigate to the My Computer icon on your desktop or press your start button and click on the 'Computer' link or icon in the start menu.
3. Once the computer contents are displayed double click on the icon / drive letter "C:". This may say something like "Local Disk (C:)" or "DELL (C:)" .
4. Now you should see the contents of your computer's C drive. Locate a folder named "DVVFVS" and right click on it. Then select the 'Copy' command.
5. Now right click in your flash drive contents window and select the 'Paste' option.
6. Use the 'safely-remove external drive' option in your system tray before removing the flash drive from your OLD computer.
7. Plug the flash drive into your NEW computer. When prompted by windows: open up the flash drive to view its contents. Locate a folder named "DVVFVS" and right click on it. Then select the 'Copy' command.
8. While leaving the flash drive contents window open on your screen navigate to the My Computer icon on your desktop or press your start button and click on the 'Computer' link or icon in the start menu.
9. Once the computer contents are displayed double click on the icon / drive letter "C:". This may say something like "Local Disk (C:)" or "DELL (C:)" .
10. Now press the CTRL and V keys on your keyboard to 'Paste' the files onto the new computer. If prompted to overwrite any files answer 'Yes' to the prompt.
11. Once this is done double-click the 'DVVFVS' folder to navigate inside it. Find a shortcut file named 'DVVFVS Shortcut' inside the directory. Right click on it and select the 'Send To -> Desktop' option.
12. Now you can double click on this shortcut on your desktop to launch VSDVVF.
